Subject: Corona camp-day activities

Dear Parents and Guardians.

Due to the Corona virus, Corona measures during the upcoming camp / day activities are important. We want to inform you about this through this letter. It is important to mention that we send the final information two weeks before the start of the camp / day activities. Unfortunately, we cannot look into a glass ball and the measures may change before we start the camp / day activities. In addition, we are still waiting for adapted protocols from Scouting Netherlands that we use as a guideline. Also whether it will be a camp or day activities determine which measures we should take.

The most important agreements that we already share with you are:

- Everyone does a health check (In the day activities every day at a camp only on arrival.)
- The parents bring their children and then go home.
- The parents do not come on the premises
- The activities are outdoors as much as possible
- If a participant falls ill, we inform the parents and the member must be picked up

Main points of attention from the protocol of last year 2020

- The sanitary area is cleaned 3 times a day
- · Participants wash their hands regularly
- Pipeline keeps 1.5 m apart from each other
- If you stay overnight, there is no room for outings such as the swimming pool or amusement park with day activities, this is possible
- When staying overnight, the sleeping area is ventilated during use throughout the evening by opening a window.
- In case of an overnight stay, the leaders and participants are in a camp bubble with as little contact as possible with other people outside the camp bubble
